

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS CAN- NOT BE PLACED IN YOUR CONTAINER

- * **HOT ASHES** - Hot ashes will melt the cart and you may be held liable for the cost of the cart replacement.
- * **BRICKS, CONCRETE, SOIL** - or other heavy objects that could damage the cart.

* **PAINT, OIL, BATTERIES, AND OTHER HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE**

The City of Cheyenne Sanitation Division currently operates the HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE for collection of these materials. Hours for this facility are Tuesday thru Friday 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. and Saturday 7am to 10:30am. Closed 12:00 to 12:30 for lunch. There is **NO CHARGE** for this service for residential customers of Laramie County.

- * **ELECTRONIC WASTE** - Computers, microwaves, TVs, VCR & DVD players, cell phones, stereos, etc., are accepted at the transfer station Tuesday thru Friday 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Closed 12:00 to 12:30 for lunch and Saturday 7am to 10:30am. Laramie County residents may bring up to 3 electronics per day at no charge.

- * **SHINGLES**— All Shingles must go directly to the city landfill.

Placement of Carts:

In order to ensure pickup, refuse carts must be placed correctly by 6:00 a.m., on your scheduled pickup day. Carts must be at street/alley with the arrows on the lid of the cart pointing toward the street/alley. It is or will be predetermined where the carts must be placed. Please call the Sanitation Division if you are unsure where to place your carts. *On windy days keep one hand on the lid when moving the cart to prevent injury.*

Trash Placed Outside of Carts:

Containers or bags placed on the outside of your container may not exceed a weight of 40 pounds.

Obstacles Near Cart or Vehicles Parked in the Street:

Carts should be at least two feet away from any vehicle or other obstacle (mailbox, tree, fence, driveway edge if blocked, etc.) In the event vehicles are parked in the street, place the cart at least two feet away from the vehicle and two feet from the curb.

Elderly and Disabled Customers:

With a doctor's note, the Sanitation Division can provide "Special Attention" services for elderly or disabled customers who are physically unable to place the cart at the curb. We will need an updated note every year. Annual Fee Schedule "Residents must present documentation from a doctor to qualify for "Special Attention," services. Documentation must be updated on an annual basis to continue in the program."

Storage and Removal of Carts:

Carts may not be stored in the street between pickups. Solid waste should not be placed at the curb or alley earlier than 4:00 p.m. of the day prior to the day of collection. Empty containers, including automated containers, must be removed from the curb, no later than twelve (12) hours following the day of collection. Failure to follow these policies may result in additional fees.



Bulky Items:

The City of Cheyenne provides special pickups of large bulky items for an additional fee. Please call the Sanitation Division for information and pricing at (307) 637-6440.

* Small material must be bagged, boxed, or in cans to control the trash and keep it from being scattered.

Standard Rates:

The current Sanitation Fee Schedule is available on the city website www.cheyennecity.org and search Sanitation Fee Schedule.

To Control Trash:

We require that you BAG ALL TRASH. City Code *Section 8.44.030* Requires customers to control their waste. Bagging your refuse will result in neat and efficient collection. Failure to bag your trash will result in additional fees if the city must dispatch a crew to clean up litter or trash. Lid locks may be added to the recycle container for a fee.
